He is editor of *A Dictionary of Asian Christianity* (Eerdmans, 2001); co-author of *A History of the World Christian Movement, Volume I* (Orbis Books, 2001) and *Volume II* (2009); and co-editor with his daughter, Caroline N. Becker, of *A History of Presbyterian Missions, 1995-2006* (WJK, 2008).

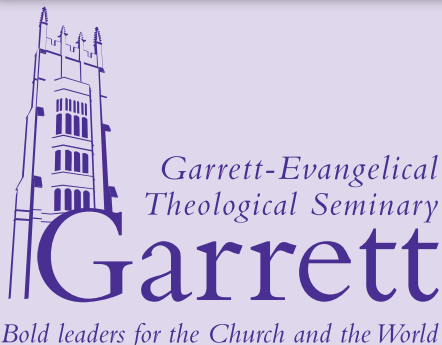
