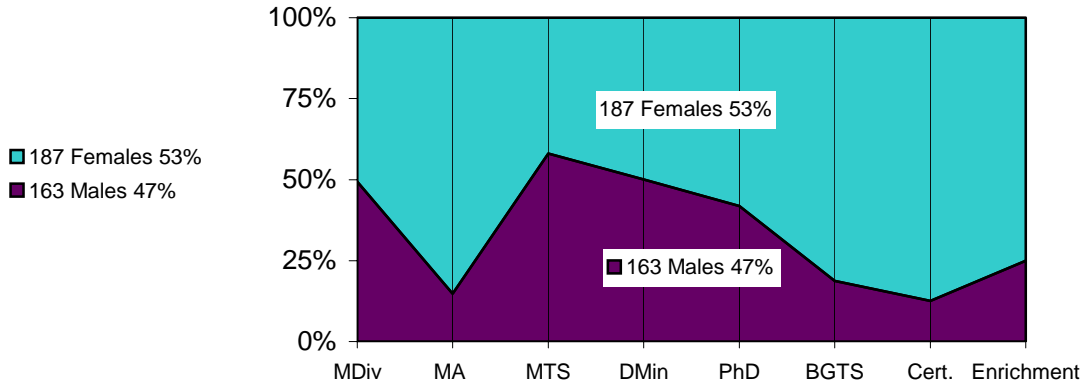

5 YEAR VIEW GENDER %

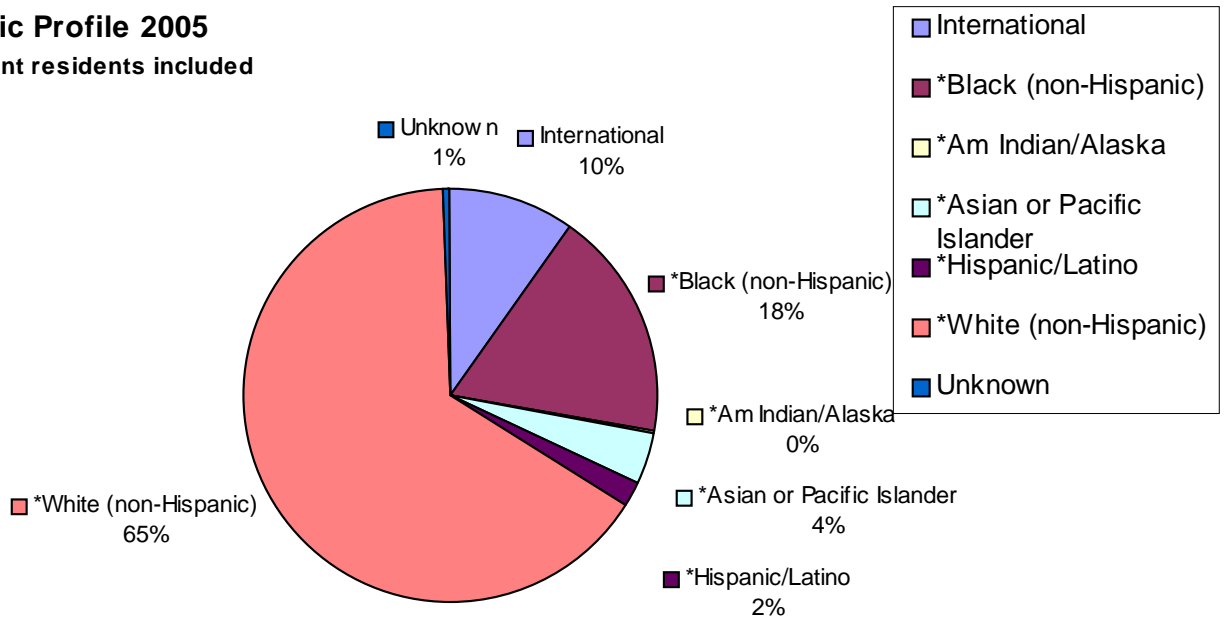

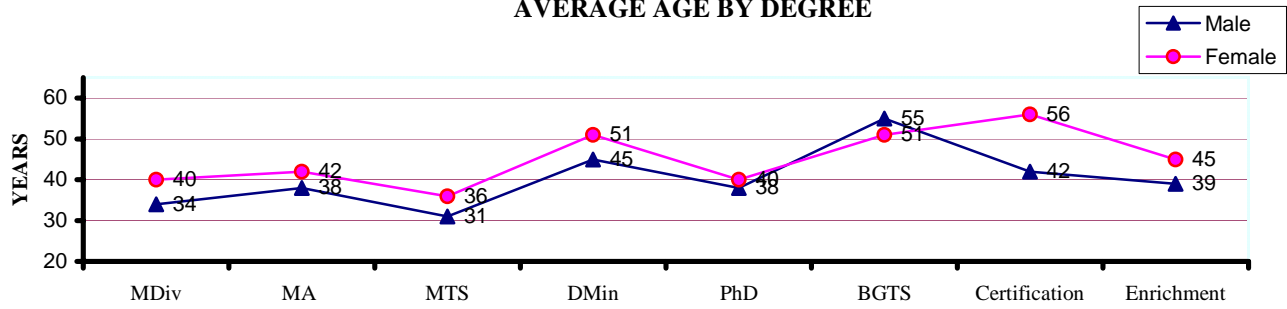

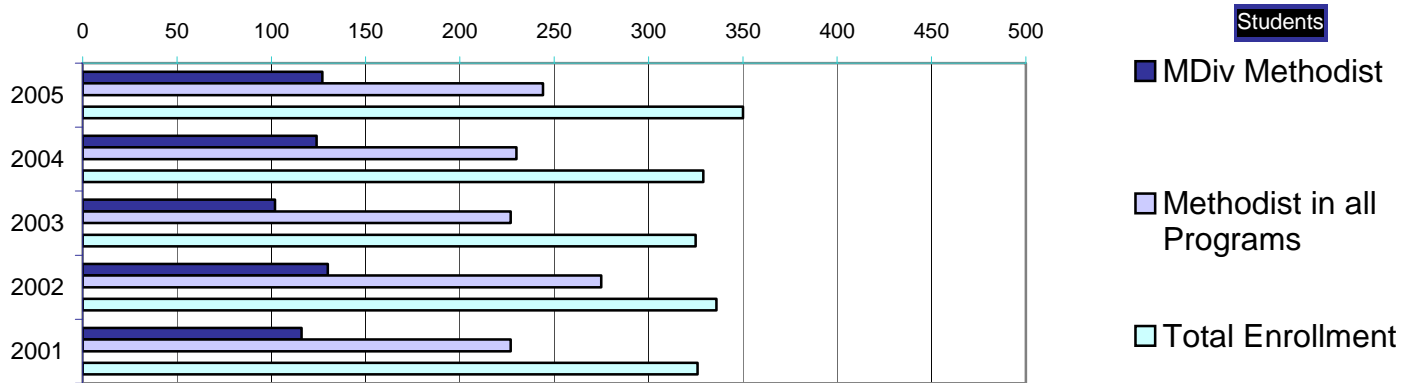
